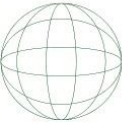

GOVERNMENT MESSAGES OF THE DAY

WORLD WATER DAY

- On this World Water Day, govt calls on citizens to work together to conserve water and ensure sustainable management of freshwater resources.
- South Africa's water supplies are under increased pressure and we urge every person to strive to save this scarce resource.
- We appeal to citizens to report water leaks and burst pipes to their respective municipalities.
- 9 out of 10 South Africans have access to clean drinking water and government is committed to its responsibility to provide safe and clean water to citizens.

ECONOMY

- Govt notes and welcomes the latest Quarterly Bulletin from the SA Reserve Bank which indicates that investment inflows into SA are more than doubled in 2018.
- We note with excitement that inward direct investment had increased to R70.7 billion in 2018 from only R26.8bn in 2017.
- Govt introduced a series of policy reforms aimed at making it easy for investors to do business in our country and we believe these are paying off.

GOVT ACHIEVEMENTS 2014- 2019- HUMAN RIGHTS

- Millions of South Africans have access to housing, health care, basic services and social welfare protection.
